

Colossians: Know Who You Are

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COLOSSIANS 3:1-17

Core Competency: Self-control

“I have the power through Christ to control myself.”

For the grace of God has appeared with salvation for all people, instructing us to deny godlessness and worldly lusts and to live in a sensible, righteous, and godly way in the present age, while we wait for the blessed hope and appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior, Jesus Christ. (Titus 2:11–13)

Using This Study

① EXAMINE His Word

What does God SAY? Open your time with prayer. The words God uses to communicate matters, so go back and pay close attention to the details emphasized or repeated in the passage.

② EXPLORE His Word

What does God MEAN? Asking questions of the text helps surface how the details relate to the message God wants to communicate.

③ EMBRACE His Word

Why does it MATTER to me? Embrace God by responding to what you discover in His word in faith and obedience.

Introduction

A number of years ago, the book *Dress for Success*, by John Molloy, became the fashion handbook for people trying to climb the corporate ladder. Molloy's advice centered on this basic principle: always dress like your boss.

I love the idea that, as God's chosen people, we always dress like our boss. That is to say, believers are to resemble God, and to reflect his character. When others look at us, they should get an idea of what God is like. That is why Paul uses the metaphor of spiritual apparel.

Take a look at God's dress code for us. In response to God's love for us, we are to clothe ourselves with "compassion, kindness, humility, and gentleness" We are to demonstrate patience and forgiveness. To top it off, we are to "put on love", which Paul says, "binds them together in perfect unity."

This Week

As believers, our spiritual clothing is of far greater significance than our physical clothing. As you study this passage, ask yourself, "Do I take time to clothe myself with attitudes that please God? Am I wearing what people most need to see: compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, patience, forgiveness and love?"

Ask God to help you to act in a way that demonstrates His character to the world around you and expresses your true identity in Christ.

① EXAMINE His Word

What does God SAY? Prayerfully note significant details and terms emphasized in the passage.

Read Colossians 3:1-17

1 So if you have been raised with the Messiah, seek what is above, where the Messiah is, seated at the right hand of God.

2 Set your minds on what is above, not on what is on the earth.

3 For you have died, and your life is hidden with the Messiah in God.

4 When the Messiah, who is your life, is revealed, then you also will be revealed with Him in glory.

5 Therefore, put to death what belongs to your worldly nature: sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desire, and greed, which is idolatry.

6 Because of these, God's wrath comes on the disobedient,

7 and you once walked in these things when you were living in them.

8 But now you must also put away all the following: anger, wrath, malice, slander, and filthy language from your mouth.

9 Do not lie to one another, since you have put off the old self with its practices

10 and have put on the new self. You are being renewed in knowledge according to the image of your

Creator.

11 In Christ there is not Greek and Jew, circumcision and uncircumcision, barbarian, Scythian, slave and free; but Christ is all and in all.

12 Therefore, God's chosen ones, holy and loved, put on heartfelt compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience,

13 accepting one another and forgiving one another if anyone has a complaint against another. Just as the Lord has forgiven you, so you must also forgive.

14 Above all, put on love—the perfect bond of unity.

15 And let the peace of the Messiah, to which you were also called in one body, control your hearts. Be thankful.

16 Let the message about the Messiah dwell richly among you, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom, and singing psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs, with gratitude in your hearts to God.

17 And whatever you do, in word or in deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him.

② EXPLORE His Word

What does God MEAN?

 - c) In what area do you need to let go or at least loosen your grip?

3. In this passage, Paul discusses sexual temptations.
 - a) Is there any connection between what you watch on TV and what is in your heart? Explain.

 - b) How does your relationship with Christ affect your TV, movie, or internet viewing habits?

4. From verses 8 and 9, what, that comes out of your mouth, does Paul says to “put away” or get rid of? What do the following scriptures have to say on the subject?
 - a) James 1:26

 - b) Matthew 15:18

 - c) Proverbs 12:22

 - d) John 8:4
