Using This Study

① EXAMINE His Word

What does God SAY? Open your time with prayer. The words God uses to communicate matters, so go back and pay close attention to the details that are emphasized or repeated in the passage.

② EXPLORE His Word

What does God MEAN? Asking questions of the text helps surface how the details relate to the message God wants to communicate.

③ EMBRACE His Word

Why does it MATTER to me? Embrace God by responding to what you discover in His word in faith and obedience.



We are now in the Christmas season and we are in full swing as we celebrate the birth of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. As we pause this morning and look back at this passage in Luke, we discover two very important truths about the person of Christ. Jesus is both fully God and fully man. This morning we will talk about why it is important for us to understand that He is both God and man, and talk about some of the dangers of seeing Him as anything less than fully God and fully man.



① EXAMINE His Word

What does God SAY? Prayerfully note significant details and terms emphasized in the passage.

Read Luke 1:30-33 (NET)

³⁰ So the angel said to her, “Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God!

³¹ Listen: You will become pregnant and give birth to a son, and you will name him Jesus.

³² He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Most High, and the Lord God will give him the throne of his father David.

³³ He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and his kingdom will never end.”

② EXPLORE His Word
