O EXAMINE His Word

What do we need to hear from God? Pay close attention to the details emphasized or repeated in these passages:

Read Galatians 3:1-3 (NASB)

¹You foolish Galatians, who has bewitched you, before whose eyes Jesus Christ was publicly portrayed as crucified?

- ² This is the only thing I want to find out from you: did you receive the Spirit by the works of the Law, or by hearing with faith?
- ³ Are you so foolish? Having begun by the Spirit, are you now being perfected by the flesh?

Read Romans 5:8 (NASB)

But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners. Christ died for us.

Read Philippians 2:13 (NIV)

... for it is God who works in you to will and to act in order to fulfill his good purpose.

Read II Peter 1:2-3 (NIV)

- ² Grace and peace be yours in abundance through the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord.
- ³ His divine power has given us everything we need for a godly life through our knowledge of him who called us by his own glory and goodness.

Read **Titus 2:11-12** (NIV)

- 11 For the grace of God has appeared that offers salvation to all people.
- ¹² It teaches us to say "No" to ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live selfcontrolled, upright and godly lives in this present age,

- Read **Luke 24:27, 31-32** (NIV) ²⁷ And beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, he explained to them what was said in all the Scriptures concerning himself.
- ³¹ Then their eyes were opened and they recognized him, and he disappeared from their sight.
- 32 They asked each other, "Were not our hearts burning within us while he talked with us on the road and opened the Scriptures to us?"

Read I Corinthians 1:30 (NIV)

It is because of him that you are in Christ Jesus, who has become for us wisdom from God—that is, our righteousness, holiness and redemption.

Read Ephesians 2:7 (NASB)

... so that in the ages to come He might show the surpassing riches of His grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.
