### Using This Study

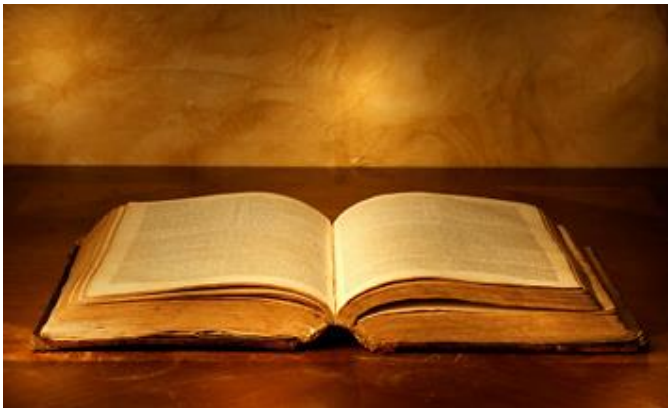
This study is designed to be used as part of our Sunday morning worship at CLBC.
