

Using This Study


This study is designed to be used as part of our Sunday morning worship at CLBC.

This week as we continue our series on “why we believe” we ask the question why we believe in the resurrection. The resurrection is the backbone of Christianity. If it did not happen then all we believe as Christians should be disregarded. If it is true then Jesus must be worshiped as Lord and Savior. This week we will look at some of the evidence. We will consider the eyewitness accounts of the disciples. We will also seek to understand what history says about the person of Jesus and His life. We will then examine the other possible alternatives to the resurrection of Jesus. Ultimately we will see why there is no other explanation for Jesus other than the truth that He rose from the grave as Lord and savior.
