### Using This Study

#### ❶ EXAMINE His Word

What does God SAY? Open your time with prayer. The words God uses to communicate matters, so go back and pay close attention to the details that are emphasized or repeated in the passage.

#### ❷ EXPLORE His Word

What does God MEAN? Asking questions of the text helps surface how the details relate to the message God wants to communicate.

#### ❸ EMBRACE His Word

Why does it MATTER to me? Embrace God by responding to what you discover in His word in faith and obedience.



Today we will look at the first part of 1 Peter Chapter 5. Peter gives specific instruction to the elders that are in the churches that he is writing to. However, the instruction that is given can be applied to all believers. The call to humility and caring for others is not something that is restricted to leadership. The mission of our church is to “love God, love people, and make fully devoted followers of Christ.” In our effort to make followers of Christ we have to disciple well. The call to shepherd others can give us insight on how to be a good disciple maker. Today we will look at how we can all apply the characteristics of being a shepherd to our lives and how this will help us make disciples for Christ.
